

Visual Art Education M.A. Exam Option Checklist

This option requires a minimum of 37 semester hours of graduate coursework; the last 18 hours of classes must correspond to students' goals and support his/her professional endeavors. Coursework must be chosen in consultation with an advisor, and must be 500-level or higher to count as graduate credit.
